**NOTES:** *The Crofton and Constance Park project is part of the Eagleland Reach segment of the San Antonio River Improvements Project (SARIP). The San Antonio River Improvements Project (SARIP) is a \$384.5 million investment by Bexar County, the City of San Antonio, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), the San Antonio River Authority (SARA) and the San Antonio River Foundation in flood control, amenities, ecosystem restoration and recreational improvements to the San Antonio River. The Eagleland Segment consists of approximately 1 mile of river length which has undergone previous channelization to reduce flood damage.*
