### **SARA'S NATURE PARKS OPEN SUNRISE TO SUNSET FOR EASTER WEEKEND**

*Mission Reach Hike & Bike Trail, Pavilions and all SARA Operated Parks will honor  
traditional operating hours of Sunrise to Sunset for Easter Weekend*

**WHAT:** The San Antonio River Authority (SARA) announced today that the agency's operated nature parks will observe regular operating hours of sunrise to sunset during the upcoming Easter Weekend. This includes the hike & bike trail, pavilions and picnic sites along the Mission Reach section of the San Antonio River Walk. Overnight camping is not permitted at any of SARA's operated nature parks. As is customary for SARA operated nature parks, park gates will open at sunrise and will close at sunset. For individuals looking to utilize one of the five pavilions located throughout the Mission Reach segment, reservations are required and are provided on a first come, first serve basis.
