PORTION OF MUSEUM REACH PEDESTRIAN SIDEWALK CLOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION

River access restricted beginning July 27. Alternate routes available.

WHAT: The San Antonio River Walk – Museum Reach pedestrian sidewalk adjacent to the CPSE Headquarters, between McCullough Avenue and Brooklyn Avenue will be closed while Sundt Construction relocates a stormwater drainage system to accommodate construction of a new parking garage facility on the property. Portions of the river trail system will be blocked during this process, but river barge access will not be impaired. Alternate routes including ADA and Go Rio access are available on Brooklyn Ave near the San Antonio River Lock and Dam. Signage will be posted informing visitors of the closure and alternate routes during this time.
