SARA HOSTS 3RD ANNUAL PECAN JUBILEE & DESSERT BAKE-OFF CONTEST

FLORESVILLE, TX— The San Antonio River Authority (SARA) has announced it will be hosting the 3rd Annual Pecan Jubilee & Dessert Bake-Off Contest at John William Helton-San Antonio River Nature Park on Saturday, November 18 in Wilson County (15662 FM 775, Floresville, TX 78114) from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. The event is free and open to the public.

The event will feature a dessert bake-off where the community is encouraged to register and submit their favorite pecan-themed baked goods in the categories of pies, cakes, bars/brownies, cookies or breads. The contest is limited to a total of 50 entries. All registered baked goods will be judged by a panel of Wilson County elected officials and students from St. Phillip's Culinary Arts program. The bake-off grand prize winner will receive a bake set (\$300 value) courtesy of Walmart of Floresville.
